Article 8

Amend section 2472 of Division 24 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:

§ 2472. Disciplinary Guidelines.

In reaching a decision on a disciplinary action under the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code section 11400 et seq.), the ~~b~~Board shall consider the disciplinary guidelines entitled "Disciplinary Guidelines," (~~Rev. 2/18/89~~(RevNew. OAL Insert Effective Date)), which are hereby incorporated by reference. Deviation from these guidelines and orders, including the standard terms of probation, is appropriate where the ~~b~~Board, in its sole discretion, determines that the facts of the particular case warrant such a deviation, for example: the presence of mitigating factors; ~~;~~; the age of the case; ~~;~~; or evidentiary problems.
