Article 8

Amend section 2472 of Division 24 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:

§ 2472. Disciplinary Guidelines.

In reaching a decision on a disciplinary action under the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code section 11400 et seq.), the <u>bB</u>oard shall consider the disciplinary guidelines entitled "Disciplinary Guidelines," (Rev. 2/18/89 (RevNew. OAL Insert Effective Date), which are hereby incorporated by reference. Deviation from these guidelines and orders, including the standard terms of probation, is appropriate where the <u>bB</u>oard, in its sole discretion, determines that the facts of the particular case warrant such a deviation, for example: the presence of mitigating factors; the age of the case; <u>or</u> evidentiary problems.
